# **BAIS Policy 2.5 School Calendar**

The Board will decide and announce the start date of the coming school year by November of the prior school year. The School Director will prepare the school calendar for the ensuing academic year by January for approval by the Board.

The calendar lists student contact days (defined as a day when students are in school), which normally number 180, and follows the North American school calendar.

Every attempt will be made to avoid setting school days on Gambian public holidays and to ensure an appropriate rest period within the academic year.

When situations prevent face-to-face classes on a long-term basis, the school will have systems in place to continue education virtually. School days held virtually will be counted as part of the 180 days of the academic calendar.

The policy statement on make-up days will be included on the calendar.

# 2.5.1 Make-up Days

The 180-day calendar includes up to five emergency days. From one to five of these days can be used for emergency closings without any changes to the calendar. Should extreme circumstances cause the number of school days to fall below the minimum of 175, the administration will determine how to make up the lost days.

Should the number of school days fall below 171, the Board shall decide if and how the remaining days should be made up
