Family Discount Plan

A reduced payment schedule is offered for any family with more than one child (same mother and father) who are enrolled at BAIS and not receiving any other reduction in their tuition. This applies to tuition only, not to other school fees.

- The oldest child pays full tuition
- The second child – a 10% reduction to tuition is offered
- The third and subsequent children - 20% reduction to tuition is offered

Finders' Fee Discount – Self-Paying Families only

A Finders' Fee Discount is paid to self-paying families who bring a new family to successfully enroll at BAIS. This applies to tuition only, not to other school fees.

- 1st Family - 30% reduction of one child's tuition
- 2nd Family - 15% reduction of the same child's tuition

General Tuition & Fee Payment Information

Tuition and fees for all students are to be paid in U.S. Dollars by bank transfer or cash deposited into the school account. Any cash deposits must be made directly to one of our bank accounts. If you cannot access US dollars, you may contact BAIS administration to make special arrangements to pay in Gambian Dalasis at the rate determined by the school. In High School, a technology fee is added to the tuition fee for Self-paying families to cover cost for infrastructure needed to maintain online coursework.

The responsibility for tuition payment rests with the parents, not with their employer.

Payment Dates

Tuition may be paid for the full year or by trimesters. Tuition for a given trimester is due in full and prior to attendance for that trimester. Invoices are sent out at least four weeks prior to the due date. Trimester due dates are stated on the invoice.

Late Payment Fee

A late payment fee of 5% will be applied to payments made after the due date. Any requests for special arrangements must be made in writing and submitted to the Director prior to the payment due date. A student is subject to removal from classes and transcripts will not be released if a tuition or fee payment is in arrears more than thirty (30) calendar days in a new trimester. Only students with a zero balance will be allowed to register for the following year.

Refunds

No refunds are made in case of early departure in a trimester. Refund of tuition will be made if the tuition was prepaid for any term in which the student does not enroll.

Application Fee for New Students and Registration Fee for Returning Students

- A non-refundable application fee of \$200 is charged for new students applying to the Banjul American International School.
- A non-refundable registration fee is charged annually for returning students. (\$100-\$200 dependent on the date you pay.)

School Development Fee

The School Development Fee is used for capital improvements, upgrades to school facilities, and for building our reserve fund to ensure the long-term sustainability of the school. This is a one-time only non-refundable fee of \$4,350 paid by each new student entering BAIS from Kindergarten through High School. Seedlings, Pre-K 1 and Pre-K 2 students pay \$1,300 each year (just under one-third of the total amount) and upon entering kindergarten the remaining balance of the \$4,350 School Development Fee is due.
